ADULT EDUCATION RESEARCH: A COMPARISON WITH THE EDUCATION METHODOLOGY IN ALBANIA

Abstract

Context: In today's reality, characterized by different transitions, rapid development and a growing demand of the labor market for people with higher qualifications and polyvalent capacities, the education during adulthood plays a crucial role to be adapted to these requirements and to stay at the same step with the development To ensure that this education to be more efficient, adult formative process should be consistent with the needs of the time and to adopt appropriate methods. Aim: To present a comparison of different scientific research in the field of adult education methodology with education methods used currently in Albania. Its objective is to analyze the level of approximation of the European practices in adult education and the practices used in the Albanian context.
