CHANGES IN THE CONTEMPORARY ALBANIAN FAMILY IN MACEDONIA

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Abstract

Family in general, is a primary social group which plays an important role in human life either individually or as a social-group. Human society cannot be recognized and investigated well without recognizing and discovering the family, particularly, its structure, family relations, the system of values, family role and its functions. Family has always played the role of mediator between the individual and society during the development of human society.
