REFORM OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM IN ALBANIA AND ITS IMPACT IN TERMS OF SOCIAL PROTECTION

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Abstract

Undertake periodic reforms in a comprehensive system, such as the social security makes them a necessity and a priority for all actors involved in decision-making. The tendency for reforms and significant improvements is also outlined in Recommendation no. 202 of the International LabourOrganisation which increasingly emphasize the establishment and maintenance of social security foundations. Since its inception, the social security system, has been the focus of legal initiatives, such as improving the existing provisions, as well as creating new spaces for improvement of the system and its adjustment to the principles of the acquis communautaire.
